Trail Happenings

Trail Improvements:

- The Friends of the Northern Rail Trail have improved the Corridor 11 rail trail from Depot Street to Holy Cross Road on Rte. 3 South. The loose stone ballast has been removed and hard pack has been installed providing a smooth trail surface which will allow for an improved snow packed groomed surface. The rail trail now has the improved hard pack base from Dyers Crossing to Holy Cross Road.
- Grant-In-Aid funding has been approved for two projects on the Franklin Falls Dam property. Hard pack will be installed on the Corridor 11 dam crossing to improve the base and allow for an improved snow packed groomed surface similar to the rail trail. Improvements will be made to the Corridor 11 gravel hill leading out of the dam gate house field which will create a safer and smoother groomed surface. Completion of these projects is expected by December 12th , 2011.
- Grant-In-Aid funding has been approved for a Pisten Bully 200S groomer to replace the New Holland Tractor the has been in use for the past eight years. The groomer is a 2001 Pisten Bully 200S with a 2011 Mogul Master Drag. This upgrade will provide the club with a newer, more powerful groomer to maintain the larger trails throughout the trail system.



OHRV Training:

- This year the club will be sponsoring an OHRV training session on December 28, 2011 at the National Guard Armory. Contact Al Carignan to reserve a spot in the class.

Work Details:

- Each Sunday the club meets to do trail maintenance at 9:00 am. Anyone who can give a few hours to help out please contact Al Carignan @ 603-934-2464. We always have work to be done and any assistance would be appreciated. GET INVOLVED TO HELP YOUR CLUB.
